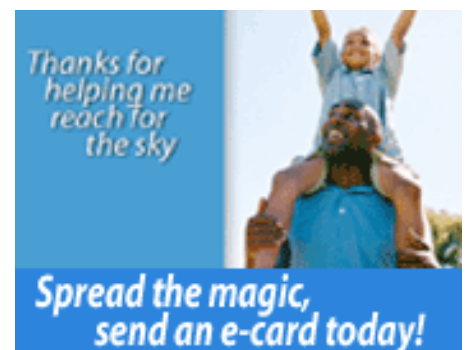
### Beta Phi
